

Terms and Conditions

- No cancellations of bookings will be accepted.
- I am aware that my child will be travelling to and from excursions on a chartered bus, all buses will be equipped with seat belts
- Risk assessments are conducted on all excursions and activities, to ensure minimal associated risk • There may be different excursions that require a waiver permission slip to be signed by a parent/guardian
- Parents must sign children in and out of the Attendance Register when dropping off and collecting children, and note the time of arrival and departure.
- Parents or guardians must advise the Centre if their child will be absent on a day that they are booked into care, including in the case of illness or family holidays.
- I acknowledge that I have read and understood the above Conditions of Enrolment and by signing this form I agree to accept and comply with the Centre's policies, terms and conditions (a full copy of current Eaton Street Centre Policies and Procedures are available at the Centre).
- I understand that while the Centre staff provide constant and careful supervision, they will not be liable whatsoever for any injury sustained to my child's person or property whilst in the Centre or on any outing organized by the Centre (unless negligence on the part of the Centre is proven). I agree to abide by these conditions of enrolment and any other that the Management Committee may bring into effect during the year.
- I give permission for staff to administer first aid or seek medical attention for my child in the event of an accident/emergency. I understand that relevant information on this form will be passed to hospital/medical staff if required. I accept liability for medical, dental, hospital, ambulance or other costs incurred.
- In the event of an accident or illness requiring emergency medical treatment every effort will be made to contact parents before such treatment is sought. Should contact prove impossible, it will be necessary for authority to be given for the treatment to be undertaken.
- I agree that if my child has no known allergy but appears to be having an anaphylactic reaction whilst at the service, or otherwise in care, the Director/Coordinator will call an ambulance and a staff member with a current First Aid Certificate will follow the recommended treatment from the ambulance staff. This may involve the administration of an adrenaline auto injector (Epipen jr or Epipen) from the service's Anaphylaxis Emergency Kit.
- I agree that if my child has difficulty in breathing whilst at the service, or otherwise in care, a staff member with a current First Aid Certificate, may administer a metered dose of inhaler/reliever medication from the service's Asthma First Aid Kit.

- I agree that if my child is older than 6 months and has a temperature higher than 38°C and is in discomfort and/or pain, whilst in care, a staff member will contact me to seek permission to administer a single dose of paracetamol mixture (such as Panadol) to my child and or if the staff can't contact me, then I give my permission to administer a single dose of paracetamol
